Clubs run by external organisations will incur a charge; however, if your child is eligible for Pupil Premium, the school will cover half of the cost. Please note that your child will be expected to attend each week. If your child stops attending, you will be required to pay the remaining balance for the term in full. If you're unsure whether your child qualifies for Pupil Premium funding, please contact the school for clarification. If you believe your child may be eligible, we encourage you to apply through the [citizen's portal](#).

A register will be taken at the start of each extra-curricular activity so please notify the school office if your child will not be attending their activity.

Please ensure that your child has their full PE kit in school if they are participating in a sporting extra-curricular activity so they are able to change before attending.
